Mrs. Helen Leach Douglas, a former resident of this place, died May 11th at the home of a son N. Stewart Douglas in Scarsdale. She was the widow of the late Dr. Edward H. Douglas.

She was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Henry S. Leach of Castile and her early life was spent in this community. Following her graduation from Buffalo General Hospital, she became superintendent of the Little Falls Hospital, a position she held until her marriage to Dr. Douglas in 1897. Dr. Douglas died 13 years later [in 1910].

Surviving are two sons, N. Stewart Douglas of Scarsdale and Andrew M. Douglas of Saratoga Springs. Surviving relatives also include four grandchildren, a sister, Harriet L. Leach of Scarsdale, and a brother, J. Murray Leach of Belvidere, Ill.

Mrs. Douglas was a member of the Universalist Church and the Daughters of the American Revolution, and was a charter member of Rock City Chapter, OES.
