CLARK DRUSE

Clark Druse, aged 77, of Richfield Springs, died Thursday at his home.

Mr. Druse was born January 1, 1881, in Warren, the son of Fayette and Anna (Mattice) Druse. He attended Paines Hollow and Fords Bush schools. On January 15, 1913, he married Cecil Leonard of Warren in Richfield Springs. They spent their married life near Warren where he operated a dairy farm until 1928 when he retired and went to Richfield Springs to live.

He was a former member of the Universalist Church in Richfield Springs [which was disbanded by the time of his death].

Surviving are his wife; three sons, Stanley, E. Albert and Frank C., all of Richfield Springs; a brother, Leon of Chicago; a sister, Mrs. Nellie Ward of Richfield Springs; and five grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. on Sunday, with the Rev. Daniel T. Hill, rector of St. John's Episcopal Church, officiating. Burial was in Springfield Center Cemetery.
