Victor, N.Y.— Mr. Truman Dryer, one of the oldest residents of Victor, died at his residence in the village last Tuesday at the age of seventy-six. He had spent his entire life in the town of his birth, and was very widely known and respected. He leaves a sister, Mrs. Bement, of Victor, two brothers, William Dryer, also of Victor, and another in Michigan, a wife, a son and a daughter. The son lives in Kansas, but has been at his father's for several weeks past during the rapid decline. The funeral is to be held at the house Saturday afternoon at two o'clock, the services to be conducted by Rev. J. F. Leland of the Universalist church to which the deceased was attached.
