MRS. EMMA DUDLEY

Mrs. Emma Hatch Dudley, aged 72 years died suddenly at her home on South Main street, some time during the night of February 3, 1935.

She had been in failing health for some time but lived alone. On Sunday her neice [niece] and family called there and she was around as usual, but not seeing her about Monday morning her neighbors investigated and found her lying on the floor, fully clothed, dead.

Mrs. Dudley was born February 8, 1863, and would have been 72 years of age on Friday next. Her maiden name was Emma Hatch and [she] was a daughter of Hiram and Lucinda Hatch.

Early in life she was united in marriage with Sidney Dudley who died several years ago [in 1920].

She leaves to mourn her, one sister, Miss Nellie Hatch of Arkport; one brother, Thomas Hatch of Jackson, Mich.; and several neices [nieces] and nephews. The body was taken to the Sheppard funeral parlors to remain until Wednesday when it will be taken to her late home on South Main street where the funeral will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 with Rev. Clara E. Morgan [Universalist] officiating. Interment will be in Maple View cemetery.
