Clarence H. Duggleby, Retired Mailman, Dies

Fort Plain—Clarence H. Duggleby, 75, of 24 Washington St., a retired rural letter carrier, died yesterday in Amsterdam Memorial Hospital.

He was born in the town of Warren, Herkimer County. He married Helen Hurlbut in 1945.
