## Death of Mrs. Nelson Duguid

Le Roy, March 11.—Mrs. Susan Smith Duguid, wife of Nelson Duguid, died at her home in Roanoke, four miles southwest of Le Roy, at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon. She had been an invalid for eight years.

Mrs. Duguid was born in Gainesville, Wyoming county, on September 29, 1838 and was married to Mr. Duguid on December 28, 1864. She had resided in this vicinity for many years. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, Homer Duguid of Roanoke, one daughter, Mrs. Dawson Van Wagnen of Gainesville, and one sister, Mrs. Lina Dunning of Washington, D. C., also one grandson, Elton Duguid of Roanoke. The funeral will be held from her late home at 2 o'clock on Saturday afternoon. The burial will be at Pavilion Center.
