Bristol, N. Y.—Entered into rest on the evening of June 4th, [Nancy], the wife of Wm. W. Dunham, and daughter of James and Roena Child, aged 36 years, 10 months and 6 days. Mrs. Dunham had been a great sufferer for several years, her disease being pulmonary consumption. Funeral from the Universalist church on Friday afternoon last at 2 o'clock. Rev. S. M. Day of Richmond delivered the funeral discourse. A large number of relatives and friends followed her remains to their last resting place in Evergreen Cemetery in Bristol. She leaves one child [Edna], a little girl nine or ten years old, who with the husband have the sympathy of the community in which they live.
