Our community was shocked last Friday morning to hear of the sudden death of Mrs. Mark Dunn. Though not feeling well of late, no one thought the end was so near. Mrs. Dunn's maiden name was Lillian Bayliss¹ and she was born in Sangerfield 46 years ago. She leaves to mourn her loss a husband and one daughter, Ethel, her mother Mrs. Ed Bayliss, and two sisters, Mrs. Rose Hayes and Mrs. Edna Spencer of Syracuse. The funeral was largely attended from the Universalist church, of which she was a member, on Tuesday afternoon, Rev. James Arby of Utica officiating. The King's Daughters of the Whatsoever circle, of which Mrs. Dunn was a member, and Summit lodge, K. of P., of which Mr. Dunn is a member, attended in a body. The floral tributes consisted of a Maltese cross of pink and white roses from the King's Daughters and a large bunch of roses from Summit lodge, K. of P. Interment was made in Madison cemetery.
