Record of a Week

The death of Mrs. Julia Huntington Durfee, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. R. Illingworth, formerly of Utica, occurred at her home in Springfield, Mass., at 1:30 o'clock Wednesday morning. She had been ill but a short time and death was due to a severe attack of pneumonia.

Mrs. Durfee was born in Utica November 24, 1882; was educated in the Utica public schools and the Utica Free Academy, was a member of the Clio Club and a member of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. Twelve years ago she married Mr. Durfee of Fall River, Mass., who survives, with one daughter, Louise. She leaves also her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Illingworth of Amsterdam; two sisters, Ida and Emily Illingworth, and one brother, G. H. Corliss Illingworth of Atlanta, Ga., and her sister, Minnie Illingworth Wright of Utica.
