Death of Mrs. Eades.

Mrs. Delliah¹ A. Hickey, widow of the late Merrill Eades, died at the home of her son Herman, in Westfield, April 10, 1915, aged 76 years. Although she had been in poor health for many years, she had been unusually well during the winter and her death was due to pneumonia, of a few days duration.

She was born in Camden, Canada, being one of a family of thirteen children of whom one only, George Hickey of Westfield, survives. When she was fourteen years old her family moved to near Rochester and two years later came to Chautauqua county where she has since lived. Mr. Eades died some four years ago [in 1909], and soon after she went to Westfield to live with her son.

Mrs. Eades was a woman of high character, a devoted wife and mother, and also a friend and neighbor will be remembered by many who have been blessed by her aid and sympathy in times of sickness and trouble. All who knew her speak only in praise and commendation of her many virtues and christian life.

Besides the brother mentioned above, she leaves two sons, Dr. H. A. Eades of Ann Arbor, Michigan, and Herman Eades of Westfield.

The remains were brought here Monday and the funeral was held at the Universalist church that afternoon, conducted by Rev. P. [Paul] W. Price. Burial in the cemetery at this place [Sherman Cemetery].
