Norman A. Eason, 56, a former Schuyler Lake boy and a resident of St. Louis, Mo., died unexpectedly, August 8 following a heart attack at his home there.

The body was brought here and funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Saturday in the Schuyler Lake Universalist Church. The Rev. George F. French, rector of Christ Episcopal Church, Cooperstown, officiated. Burial was made in the family plot in Schuyler Lake Cemetery.

Mr. Eason was born July 17, 1900 in the town of Richfield, son of Stewart and Myrta (Loomis) Eason. He married Marjorie Barber in 1926 at Newark Valley.

He was in charge of sales promotion for the chemical division of the Lion Oil Company and had moved to St. Louis only a week ago. Prior to that time he had lived in El Dorado, Ark. He was a member of the Schuyler Lake Lodge, F. and A. M.

He is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Roberta Hollen, Little Rock, Ark.; two sons, Richard, serving in the Air Force, and Norman A. Jr. of New Orleans, La.; two grandchildren; his father Stewart Eason, Schuyler Lake; one sister, Mrs. John R. Hauf of Albany; and several nieces and nephews.

Schuyler Lake Masonic Lodge conducted memorial services at 8 p.m. Friday at the home of the father of the deceased.
