Miss Helen M. Eddy died on Dec. 1st, after a three days illness with Bright's disease. She had made her home with her sister, Mrs. Eunice Rice, in Albion since April, 1902. She was born and had spent much of her life in Barre. She was of a quiet, self-sacrificing nature, and her life work was doing good to others. Her only brother, Emmett Eddy, of Sandwich, Ill., arrived just after her death. The funeral Thursday afternoon was largely attended, her niece, Mrs. Dr. F. D. Cady of Rochester, and old neighbors from South Barre and West Albion being present, Rev. A. [Arthur] W. Grose [Universalist] officiating. The floral offers were fitting tributes. Her cousins, Daniel and George Culver, Eli Atwell, Mark Porter, George Warner and Homer Brown, gently laid her to rest beside her mother at Mount Albion. She was 65 years of age.
