Mrs. Sarah Ann Eddy passed peacefully away on Saturday morning, July 15th, aged 89 years. She came to Barre with her father's family in 1828, and began keeping house on the farm where she died seventy years ago, but it has changed ownership several times since and is now owned by her nephew, Homer Culver. She was tenderly cared for by her daughter, Miss Helen Eddy, and Mrs. Eunice Rice of West Albion. One son also survives her, Emmet Eddy, of Sandwich, Ill., two sisters and two brothers and a large circle of relatives and friends. She was kind and sympathetic and acted the part of a mother to others than her five grown children. The funeral was held from the house, Rev. Dr. [Charles] Flurher [Universalist] of Albion officiating. Interment was at Mt. Albion. Nephews of the deceased acted as bearers as follows: B. H., D. D. and G. F. Culver, M. C. Porter, Eli Atwel, John Foreman. Her work was well done. Many rise up and call her blessed.
