LITTLE FALLS — Floyd J. Edick, 92, of Fall Hill Road, RD 3, died this morning in Little Falls Hospital, following an illness of several months.

He was born on Jan. 10, 1878 in Paines Hollow, the son of Andrew A. and Mary Willard Edick. He was educated in rural schools and married Ida Brondstatter on Jan. 13, 1904 in the Town of Ohio.

Mr. Edick owned and operated his farm until retiring eight years ago. He was a member of St. Paul's Universalist Church and a 50-year member of the Little Falls Grange No. 611.
