Samuel Gilbert Eggleston

Antwerp, June 14.—Samuel Gilbert Eggleston, one of Antwerp's well known and oldest residents, who had been quite feeble for some time, died at his home in Academy street Sunday afternoon at 3, aged 86 years, 6 months and 24 days.

He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Jennie Murray, Mrs. George Rastley and Miss Hazel Eggleston, of Antwerp, and by five sons, Eugene, of Carthage, and Benjamin, William, Perry and Carl Eggleston, of Antwerp.

His funeral will be held from the house Tuesday afternoon, at 2, and it is expected that the Rev. H. W. [Harry Westerbrook] Reed, Universalist minister of Watertown, will officiate, and the burial will be in charge of Antwerp Lodge, No. 226, F. and A. M., of which the deceased was a member. Burial will be made in the family plot here in Hillside cemetery.
