Aged Resident of Morris Dead

Morris, April 17.—Walter H. Elliott, an aged and respected resident of this township, died April 13 from the effects of a shock [a stroke] which a few hours before he suffered. He had been to pump water for his cows, and not immediately returning, his housekeeper, Miss Adella Jackson, went to look for him, and found him lying in an unconscious condition upon the ground. Help was at once summoned but he only briefly regained consciousness and died about ten o'clock that evening.

Mr. Elliott was 83 years of age and had lived in Morris most of his lifetime. He is survived by one sister, Mrs. Margaret Weeks and several nephews and nieces. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from his late home at Elm Grove. Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard of the Universalist church officiated and interment was in Hillington cemetery.
