The many friends of Mrs. Julia A. Embry were shocked and deeply grieved to learn of her sudden death, which occurred on Sunday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. F. T. [Mary] Rowley. Mrs. Embry had enjoyed splendid health during the past winter and spring and was a helpful companion in the home up to the time of her death. On Saturday evening she suffered an attack of indigestion which became acute and resulted in her death the following evening.

Julia A. Loveland was born in Honeoye Falls, February 5, 1840. She was the daughter of Asa [Asel] S. and Mary Conover Loveland. Nearly all of her life was spent in the town of Victor. On December 22, 1864, she was united in marriage to Napoleon B. Embry, of this village, who died May 1, 1876. Two children were born to this union, Mary E. Rowley, who survives, and one son, Georgie, who died at the age of four years.

For the past five years, Mrs. Embry had made her home with her daughter in this village. She was a regular attendant of the Universalist church. As a neighbor and friend she will be remembered for her loving thoughtfulness of others. Her gentle manner and cheery smile will linger long in the memory of her many friends.

Funeral services were held on Wednesday afternoon, Rev. E. [Edwin] P. Wood officiating. Interment was made in the village cemetery.
