The death of Clarinda P. Evans occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Frank [Cora] Ahl in the town of Gainesville, last Friday, October 23rd. Deceased was born in Gainesville, January 31, 1834, being 74 years of age at the time of her death. She was the daughter of Nehemiah and Ursula Brown and lived in the town of her birth all her life. Her parents settled in the town of Gainesville in 1802. In January 1850, she was united in marriage to Nelson Evans. Eight children were born to them, and the following survive; Mrs. Frank Ahl, Mrs. Helen Grover, James C. Evans and Leon Evans of the town of Gainesville and N. W. Evans of Warsaw, also several grand children. She was one of a family of ten children, and two sisters, Mrs. Hannah Granger of Hermitage and Mrs. Thecla Axtell of Frankfort, Michigan and one brother Oliver J. Brown of Woodbury, Tennessee, are now living. Mrs. Evans was kind and affectionate in disposition and was greatly beloved and esteemed by a host of friends who had known her from her childhood and admired her for her many sterling qualities of character.

Funeral services were attended from the home where she died, Monday afternoon at two o'clock, Rev. Clara Morgan of the Universalist Church in Perry officiating, with burial in the Gainesville cemetery. The beautiful floral tributes and large gathering of relatives and friends at the funeral services showed how she was loved and respected.
