MRS. EMILY EWING

Middleport, April 28.—The death of Mrs. Emily Ewing, who yesterday celebrated her 87th birthday, occurred this morning at her home on the Telegraph road. Mrs. Ewing was one of the pioneer settlers of this section, dwelling at what is now Freeman's Corners when the village of Middleport was not yet in existence. She was a member of the First Universalist Church. Her funeral will be held Tuesday at 2 o'clock at the house, the Rev. L. C. Nichols of the Universalist church officiating. Interment will be made at Mountain Ridge. She leaves two sons, William S. of New York city, and James of this village, and one daughter, Mrs. Mary [?] of California.
