MRS. MILDRED EYGABROAT

Mrs. Charles Eygabroat, aged 60, of Richfield Springs, died on Saturday in Iliion Hospital where she had been a patient for four weeks.

Mrs. Eygabroat was born on June 22, 1895, the daughter of Eugene and Minnie Talbot MacGeen. She attended school in South New Berlin. She was married to Charles Eygabroat in the Methodist parsonage in Richfield Springs in 1916. The couple first resided in South Columbia where Mr. Eygabroat operated a farm and in the spring of 1938 moved to the Chamberlin farm on the West Lake Road. Mr. Eygabroat died on January 14, 1956.

She was a member of the AWA Society of the Universalist Church of Schuyler Lake and a former member of the Richfield Grange.

Surviving is one son, Howard Charles Eygabroat, Richfield Springs; a daughter, Mrs. Ferris Foster, Frankfort; a brother, Dolph E. MacGeen, The Chyle; one sister, Mrs. Claude Richardson, Richfield Springs and three grandchildren.

Funeral services were held on Monday from McGrath Funeral Home at the convenience of the family, with the Rev. Douglas W. Passage, pastor of the West Wingate Federated Church, officiating. Burial will be in Lakeview Cemetery in the spring.
