MRS. ANNETTA B. EYSAMAN

Little Falls—Mrs. Annetta Bucklin Eysaman, 88, died at the local hospital Jan. 25, 1939. Death was due to a fractured hip, resulting from a fall recently at her home, 44 West Main St.

She was born in Smalls Bush, Town of Little Falls, daughter of George Rodney and Elizabeth Harter Bucklin. She was married to Otis E. Eysaman in 1874, and they took up their residence on a small farm two miles west of this city. About 60 years ago they moved to this city and Mr. Eysaman, a former alderman, died about 20 years ago. Mrs. Eysaman was a member of St. Paul's Universalist Church and its Ladies Aid Society.

There survive two sons, George I. Eysaman, this city, and Charles E. Eysaman, Paulsboro, N.J.; four grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

A private funeral will be held from her home Saturday at 2 p.m., with the Rev. Howard Gilman, pastor, Universalist Church, officiating. Burial will be made in Church Street Cemetery.
