## Archie S. Failing

Archie S. Failing, 62, 1644 Miller, local plumber, died unexpectedly in his home yesterday morning, June 11, 1949.

Dr. Herman J. Haberer, Coroner, expressed the belief that he died in his sleep about 6 a.m. of a cardio vascular ailment.

Mr. Failing was born in Fort Plain, a son of the late Charles and Nellie Sutliff Failing. On Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 23, 1910, he married Miss Jennie T. Dreizler in St. John's Church. He was a member of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. He had conducted his own plumbing business for some time.

Besides his wife he leaves a brother, Julius R. Failing, Nelliston; three daughters, Mrs. Frank Dressel, Mrs. Michal Fiore and Ruth Lamar Failing, all of Utica, and two sons, Paul S. and Archie L. Failing, Utica, several grandchildren, and a niece.
