Little Falls.—George H. Failing died at his home in the Failing Block yesterday afternoon of Bright's disease, after an illness of over a year. Mr. Failing was born at Fort Plain October 8, 1843, being a son of the late Philip Failing of Frey's Bush. He had lived in this city for about 30 years, being engaged in the bakery business here, then at Herkimer and later at Fort Plain. The deceased was a member of the Universalist Church. He was a conscientious, honorable man, to whom many friends were attracted by his pleasing personality. The relatives surviving are two brothers, Robert of Fly Creek and John P. of Fort Plain; and three sisters, Mrs. Chauncey Moyer and Miss Violette Failing of Frey's Bush and Mrs. Charles Button of Fort Plain.
