

[Fales, Harriet Hale]

—After a protracted illness Mrs. Harriet Fales, the esteemed wife of Water Commissioner Fales, died Saturday evening at her home, 16 Fourth street. The deceased was born in North Dana, Mass., March 29, 1822, and was the daughter of Barnard Hale, a respected resident of that place. In 1841 she married Joseph Fales, and in the same year they removed to Troy, where they resided continuously to the time of her death. Mrs. Fales was a member of the Universalist church of this city, and had been one of its active workers in various societies during many years. She was beloved by a wide circle of friends. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, George B. Fales, clerk of the water board, and a daughter, Mrs. O. F. Kinloch.
