FRANK F. FARGO[, ] FORMER TAXI MAN[, ] DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Frank Ferguson Fargo, aged 52 years, died at this home, 131 Monroe avenue, at 3:10 o'clock Thursday afternoon. Mr. Fargo had been suffering from diabetes for some time and had been confined to his home for the past four weeks.

Mr. Fargo was born at Fargo, Jefferson county, December 26, 1872, son of the late Lewis and Susan Penniman Fargo. He passed the early part of his life at Carthage. He moved to this city about 14 years ago, where he has since resided.

He married Mabelle Kitts of Gouverneur about 30 years ago [in 1894]. While in Watertown Mr. Fargo for many years operated a taxi service having a stand on the square. Recently Mr. Fargo was engaged as a salesman for the Shaughnessy Knitting Mills.

He is survived by his widow, and three children: Mrs. Gordon Bush, Mrs. Gladys Finn and Donald K. Fargo all of this city, and one brother, Lote Fargo of Carthage.

The funeral service will be held at the home, 131 Monroe avenue, Saturday, 11 A.M. Burial will be made in the family plot at Carthage. Rev. [George Delbert] Walker of the Universalist church of Carthage will officiate.
