SUSAN J. FARLEY

In the death of Mrs. Susan J. Farley Sunday morning February 21, 1909, one of the old inhabitants of the town of Springport was called away. She was born March (??) 1825 in Canandaigua, New York and in 1840 removed to Naples, New York. In 1847 she was married to Dr. Horace Hills Farley of Dansville, New York, where they resided until 1855, when the family removed to Union Springs, where she has since lived.

Mrs. Farley is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Mary J. Utt and Miss Harriett L. Farley, and two grandchildren, Charles DeWitt and Susan Farley Anderson.

The funeral services were held at her late home, No. 12 Center street Wednesday afternoon, February 24, 1909, Rev. Arnold S. Yantis of the First Universalist church of Auburn, N.Y. officiating. A large number of friends and relatives attended and the floral tributes showed plainly the esteem in which Mrs. Farley was held by those who knew her best.
