The death of Thomas J. Farmer occurred at his home in Nelliston at an early hour Tuesday morning. He had been confined to his bed about two weeks. His death removes one of the older citizens of that vicinity. Deceased was a native of Brooklyn, but had been a resident of Nelliston for nearly forty years. He was employed for many years by the grocery firm of Wood & Clark. For a short time he conducted a business of his own, but latterly he had been associated with the furniture concern of Adams & Hix. He was well known and enjoyed the respect of his friends. He is survived by his widow [Minerva J. Pealer]; one son, the Rev. Thomas Farmer, of Lockport; three daughters, Gertrude, Helen and Hazel, of Nelliston, and one brother, Peter, and one sister, Rachel Eaker, of Johnstown. The funeral will be held at his home Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock, the Rev. L. [Lewis] J. Richards of the Universalist church officiating.
