NEWS AND VIEWS FROM HANNIBAL

Following an illness of several weeks due to a mastoid infection, Miss Florence Farnham died early Monday morning in the Ithaca hospital. The deceased was born at North Hannibal, June 14, 1877, daughter of the late Tryphena Darling Farnham and George N. Farnham, well-known pioneer Hannibal families. Miss Farnham studied at North Hannibal school and Fulton high school. She was devoted to her home and family giving loving and constant care for many months to her mother who died last spring. Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Edna Van Auken, Hannibal; Mrs. Gertrude Haws, South Hannibal; one brother, Burdette Farnham, supervisor of Minetto. The funeral was held Wednesday at 2 p. m. from the home of M. H. Van Auken, Hannibal with interment at Fairdale. Rev. J. M. Kearns, pastor of the First Universalist church of Ithaca, of which the deceased was a member, officiated. Bearers were Courtney Shutts, Ralph Stark, George A. Wells, S. R. Lockwood, Phillip Haws and M. H Van Auken.
