Death of an Aged and Nearly Lifelong Resident of Alabama

Corfu, Feb. 10.—Nathaniel C. Fenner, aged 88 years, died from dropsy at his home, three quarters of a mile south of Alabama station, on Tuesday afternoon.

Mr. Fenner was born at Henrietta, being one of a family of 16 children. At an early age he moved with his parents to Alabama and had lived in that vicinity ever since. In 1840 he was married to Miss Eliza Case, who died in 1852. On April 3, 1881, he was married to Mrs. Miranda Fenner, who survives him, with two daughters, Mrs. Clarissa Marble of Alabama and Miss Rozelle Fenner of Akron, and two stepdaughters, Mrs. Charles Moore and Mrs. John Wright, both of Indian Falls.

The funeral will be held from the family home at 11 a.m. on Saturday, the Rev. Harry M. Wright [Universalist] of Batavia officiating. The interment will be at South Alabama.
