Was Born in New Berlin

John Field died at his home in Columbus, O., Saturday evening, Nov. 12, 1898, of neuralgia of the heart.

He was born in New Berlin, in 1806, and was in his earlier years a civil engineer, in which capacity he went to Ohio in 1824, and settled in Columbus in 1829, being engaged also in the lumber business there, 1836 to '70, when he retired. Three years ago he fell and fractured his left hip, and since that time had been confined to his bed or an invalid chair, though his health was otherwise excellent until within two days of his death. He was a member of the Universalist church. He leaves in Ohio two sons and two nieces, adopted as daughters, and also had several relatives in this section.
