MRS. FILE DIES; ILL ONLY 3 DAYS

Was a Resident of Fayetteville and Vicinity for Past 30 Years

FAYETTEVILLE—Mrs. Harriet File, (61?) of Mycenae died Saturday, May 9, in the Crouse-Irving hospital [in Syracuse] where she had been a patient for three days. Death was attributed to apoplexy.

Mrs. File had been a resident of Fayetteville and vicinity for the past 30 years, until last fall when she and Mr. File moved to Mycenae to make their home with the latter's aunt. She leaves a host of friends who regret her sudden passing.

Rev. Ellsworth C. Reamon, pastor of the Betts Memorial Universalist Church of Syracuse, of which she was a member, conducted the services at the home Monday afternoon at 4 o'clock. Burial was made in Kirkville.

Besides her husband, Harry File, she is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Blanchard Wilson of Canastota and a granddaughter, Virginia Wilson.
