LEANDER FITTS DEAD The Well Known Moravian Dies at His Home— End of an Honorable Career

Ex-Assemblyman Leander Fitts, whose serious illness was reported in the BULLETIN Wednesday, died at his home in Moravia this morning.

Mr. Fitts was born in Sempronius, this county, May 28, 1822. He was educated at the district schools and in the Groton Academy and the Moravia Institute. When a young man he was a teacher, and afterwards engaged in business successfully. He has been connected with the First National bank of Moravia as a director, cashier, and president, which office he has filled to the time of his death. Mr. Fitts was a man greatly esteemed in the community where he spent his life. He was conscientious in all his dealings with men, courteous and kind. He served several terms in the Board of Supervisors and was elected Member of Assembly to represent the Second Cayuga district in 1888 and 1889.
