JAMES HERVEY FLAGLER

Batavia, Aug. 6.—James Hervey Flagler died at his home in Corfu last night after a long illness. He was born in Chenango county, March 5, 1820 and when a young child moved to York. In (1833?) he removed to Darien. His father was the Rev. John S. Flagler, a Universalist clergyman. Mr. Flagler was twice married, his first wife being Miss Susan Tinney, who died in 1855, and his second wife Miss Mary A. Griswold, who died June 6, 1906. He was at one time captain of the militia and served as a justice of the peace and inspector of schools. He was a member of Corfu Universalist church. He leaves no nearer relatives than nephews and nieces.
