## ASA L. FLANSBERG PASSES AWAY THURSDAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Schuyler Lake, Sept. 7.—Asa L. Flansburg passed away at his home in this village Thursday morning after a three years' illness from cancer. Mr. Flansburg was a son of John and Sally M. Lord Flansburg and was born at Davenport Center March 8, 1847. He was united in marriage to Viola Pope of Toddsville, Dec. 31, 1866 and his whole life had been spent in this vicinity.
