G. M. FLANSBURG DROPS DEAD AT CHURCH DOOR

Schuyler Lake—Stricken with a heart attack as he was about to enter the Universalist Church, George M. Flansburg, 64, local grocer, died unexpectedly yesterday afternoon.

He was accompanied by Mrs. Flansburg and Mrs. George Randall, a sister, when seized with a heart attack. They were arriving for worship at 2 p.m. He was taken into the church until the arrival of Dr. H. V. Frink, Richfield Springs coroner.

Mr. Flansburg was born in Oaksville, son of Asa L. and Vina Pope Flansburg. He assisted his father in the grocery business until his parent's death in 1917, when he took over the store. He had conducted it since.

He married Inez Bliss June 30 [20], 1894. Mr. Flansburg was a member of Schuyler Lake Lodge (1??), F&AM; Richfield Chapter, RAM, Richfield Springs; Otsego Commandery, Knights Templar, Cooperstown; and of the First Universalist Church.

He leaves Mrs. Flansburg, Mrs. Randall, and a son, Marshall, Earlville.

Knights Templar rites will be conducted with the funeral at 2 p.m. Tuesday, in the Universalist Church.
