MRS. VINA A. FLANSBURG

Mrs. Vina A. Flansburg, aged 83, died at 9:30 o'clock Sunday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George Randall of Hamilton. Death followed a long illness aggravated by the infirmities of age.

Mrs. Flansburg was for 38 years a resident of Schuyler Lake, moving to Hamilton three years ago to make her home with her daughter. The funeral was held at 3 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Schuyler Lake Universalist Church of which she was a member. Rev. W. H. Skeels, pastor of the church, will officiate, and burial will be made in the Schuyler Lake Cemetery.

Vina A. Pope was born in Toddsville July 12, 1848. Her marriage to Asa L. Flansburg took place 64 years ago, and for a time the couple made their home at Oaksville, where Mr. Flansburg operated a cotton mill. They moved to Schuyler Lake 41 years ago, and for many years Mr. Flansburg managed a store here. His death occurred in 1917.

Mrs. Flansburg gained many friends during her long residence in this place and was a woman who was highly respected in the community.

Relatives who survive her are the daughter previously mentioned; a son, George F. Flansburg of Schuyler Lake; a sister, Mrs. Daniel Chapman of Hyde Park; two grandsons, Harry Randall of Troy and Marshall Flansburg of Earlville; three great grandchildren; and several nephews and nieces.
