H. W. Flick Dies at 75

Henry W. Flick, 75, retired Perch River farmer, died this morning at 6:45 in the House of the Good Samaritan, where he had been a patient since Sunday. Afflicted with emphysema, he had been ill a number of years.

The funeral will be Friday afternoon at 2 at the family home. Rev. Blaine F. Hartford, pastor of the All Souls Universalist church, will officiate. Burial will be in the Dexter cemetery.

The body will be taken home this afternoon.

Surviving Mr. Flick are his wife, Mrs. Clarice Brown Flick; a daughter, Mrs. James G. (Eunice L.) Fisk, Brownville; five grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

A son Francis H. Flick, Perch River, died in the same hospital Jan. 15, 1959, at the age of 35.

Mr. Flick was born near Perch River, town of Brownville, April 23, 1891, a son of Henry W. and Jennie Smith Flick. He had lived in that area all his life and followed the farming occupation until his retirement about eight years ago.

He married Miss Clarice Brown of this city, formerly of the town of Pamelia, Feb. 23, 1918 in this city. They had lived on the same farm for the past 48 years.

Mr. Flick was a member of the Perch River grange.
