Mrs. Eliza C. Flint

Mrs. Eliza Catherine Young Flint, aged 75 years, died Sunday afternoon at the home of her daughter¹, Mrs. Mortimer [Mary] Smith, at the Montgomery county almshouse, in Palatine, of pneumonia, following a stroke of paralysis. Mrs. Flint was born at Brookman's Corners, in the town of Minden, and passed practically all of her life in that town. For the past three or four years she had made her home with a relative, Fenton Ottman, at Lykers, but after being stricken two weeks ago was moved to the residence of her daughter. Mrs. Flint was twice married, her first husband being George Hufnail, and the second George Flint, both deceased. She is survived by three children, as the result of the first union, former County Clerk Frank E. Hufnail, of Fort Plain, John Hufnail, of Minden, and Mrs. Mortimer Smith, of Palatine. She also leaves a sister, Mrs. Margaret Pickard, of Fort Plain. Another sister, Mrs. Charlotte Stowitts, of Flat Creek, died about ten days ago. The funeral will be held at the home of Frank E. Hufnail at Fort Plain, Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Frank Moulton of the Universalist church officiating. Interment will be in the Fort Plain cemetery.
