Y., at the time of his death. The deceased is survived by one daughter, Georgella Forbes, of Washington, D. C.

Funeral services were held at her late residence, 1680 Irving St. N. W., Washington, D. C., at 10 a. m. Thurstay [sic], January 25, Dr. C. E. Rice of the Universalist Church in Washington officiating. The remains were brought to Potsdam where they were placed in the receiving vault at Bayside cemetery.
