CHESTER FORD—

At 4:45 this morning occurred the death of Chester Ford, at the home of his son Elmer Ford in West Main street. Mr. Ford was born in Fox Hollow 80 years ago. He had lived in Paine's Hollow and Little Falls, following the business of cheese making. About 60 years ago he married Miss Mary Catherine Heath, who preceded him in death by five years. He was an attendant of the Universalist Church and a staunch Democrat in politics. Surviving him are one son, Elmer Ford of Mohawk, with whom he was living at the time of his death, and two daughters, Mrs. Mary Sharpe of Herkimer and Mr. John Eysman of Little Falls, five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. The funeral will be held from the home of his son, Elmer Ford, Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Arthur Moody of the Methodist church officiating. Interment will be made in Oak Hill Cemetery, Herkimer.
