FORT PLAIN, April 15.—George Ford, an aged and respected resident of Dimmick Hollow, died Sunday at 10 a.m. of pneumonia and heart trouble. He was seventy-six years of age and was born and married on the farm on which he died. He was a son of Albert and Emily (Wood) Ford, who were early residents in the community where they died. He is survived by his wife, formerly Miss Caroline Angell, and by two daughters and a son. They are Mrs. Theodore Fox of New York city, Mrs. Glynn Daniels, who resided on the homestead with her parents, and Albert Ford of West Morris.

The funeral was held Wednesday at 1 p.m. from his late home, the complete cycle of his existence. The Rev. F.G. Leonard of the Morris Universalist church of Morris officiated, and interment was made in the Hillington cemetery.
