DEATH NEAR HALLSPORT Mrs. Eliza Forsythe Passed Away Sunday Morning

Mrs. Eliza Forsythe, who has been ill for some time, died Sunday morning at 5:15 o'clock. Early last Wednesday morning she suffered a shock [stroke] from which she never rallied. The funeral services were held at the house Tuesday, at 10:30, Rev. E. Alice Bradley officiating. Interment in the Baptist cemetery at this place.

Miss Elia Richardson was born at Livonia, Livingston county, in July, 1832, and moved with her parents into this section in May, 1839. During the year 1848 she was married to William Forsythe, who died at the homestead a few years ago. Deceased is survived by one son and three daughters: George Forsythe, with whom she resided; Mrs. E. J. Hall of Marion, Ind.; Mrs. C. L. Parker of Detroit, Mich.; and Mrs. George Wilmot of Hallsport. Also one sister and four brothers: Mrs. J. E Hile, Messrs. C. C. Richardson and Thompson Richardson of this village; Fayette Richardson of Wellsville and George Richardson of Port Allegany.

Mrs. Forsythe was a lady held in high esteem by all, and her death will be mourned by numerous friends. She was a member of the Universalist church in this village.
