MRS. HERBERT FOSTER

Mrs. Flora Videarie Foster, wife of Herbert Foster of the Fly Creek Valley, died Saturday morning at her home after a year's illness.

Born August 25, 1855, in Binghamton, Mrs. Foster was the daughter of Decatur and Mary (Eckler) Thayer. She was twice married, the first husband having been William Hoke. She married Mr. Foster in 1888. He survives, with one daughter, Mrs. Edwin M. Jarvis of Fly Creek, and several cousins.

Mrs. Foster was a former member of the Universalist church in Springfield Center [disbanded by the time of her death].

Funeral services were held Tuesday at 1 o'clock from the Ingalls Funeral Home in Cooperstown. The Rev. Charles Kramer, retired Universalist pastor, officiated, and interment was in Springfield Center cemetery.
