MRS. JOSEPHINE FOSTER

Mrs. Josephine M. Foster, 78, widow of Charles T. Foster of Dexter, died at her home in that village late Saturday afternoon. Death was due to complications. Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at 2 from the home. Burial was made at Dexter.

Mrs. Foster was born in Dexter, May 15, 1845. Her father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. James Moffatt, were among the first settlers in Dexter, coming to that village where there were but four houses in the village. She was married in Dexter to Charles T. Foster who died in 1910. Her entire life had been spent in that village. She was an active member of the Universalist Church of Dexter and very interested in church affairs. She was a member of the Brownville Lodge, Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving Mrs. Foster are one son, Brayton C. Foster of Dexter and one grandson and two granddaughters, all of Dexter.

Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed, D. D., pastor of the All Souls Universalist Church of Watertown, officiated at the funeral services which were conducted Monday afternoon.
