MRS. FOSTER, 42, OF DEXTER, PASSES AWAY

Chaumont, April 26.—Mrs. Mary M. Foster, 42, wife of Edson A. Foster, a resident of the Dexter-Brownville road and active member of the Dexter clubs passed away yesterday morning at 9 o'clock at her home after being in ill health for more than a year.

Mrs. Foster was born in the town of Hounsfield, a daughter of Hubert B. and Jane Livermore Maynard, and went to Brownville with her parents when a girl. On February 19, 1907 she became the bride of Edson A. Foster of Dexter and they had made their home on a farm in the town of Brownville since.
