CHARLES W. FRAME

Charles Wheeler Frame, former resident of Clinton, died Thursday, June 7, in Utica at the age of 72. He had been in poor health for several years.

Born in Barneveld on November 15, 1872, he was the son of Schuyler and Caroline Humphrey Frame. He was employed by the American Railway Express Company for 34 years before his retirement 11 years ago.

In 1892 he married Belle Burgess, of Utica, who died in 1933. He was a member of the [Universalist] Church of the Reconciliation, Utica. The family lived in Clinton for several years, residing on Prospect street.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Mildred Weigel and Misses Ruth and Isabell Frame, all of Utica; and a granddaughter, Lt. Barbara R. Weigel, Army Nurse Corps, Santa Fe, N. M.

Funeral services were held on Saturday afternoon, with interment in Sunset Hill Cemetery, Clinton.
