Allen's Hill, N. Y.—Seth Francis, a respected citizen of this place, aged 71 years, died very suddenly of apoplexy, at his late residence, Wednesday, January 8th. Funeral services were held from the Universalist church of Bristol, Saturday, the 11th.

—Seth Francis, an old resident of Allen's Hill, died very suddenly last week Wednesday. He was standing by the window talking with Mrs. Francis, apparently in his usual health, and was calling her attention to something, but just as he spoke fell to the floor and almost immediately expired. He had been to the village the day before, and those who saw him spoke of his looking so well. The cause of his death was apoplexy. The funeral was held at Baptist Hill the following Saturday, the Rev. Mr. [Charles O.] Barber [Universalist] of that place officiating. He was in the 72d year of his age.
