GUSTAV FREYGANG DIES FOLLOWING OPERATION

Gustav Freygang, for many years a well known resident of this village [Dolgeville], died at midnight Sunday at the Little Falls hospital where he underwent an operation a week ago for complication of diseases. Mr. Freygang was born in Germany, February 24, 1859, and was the son of the late Adolph and Margaret Weile Freygang. For over 60 years, the deceased was engaged in the making of felt shoes and slippers. He came to this village in 1884 to work for Alfred Dolge, and later was employed by the Daniel Green Felt Shoe Company. In this village 46 years ago he married Rosa Franz. Surviving besides the wife is a brother, Emil, who lives in Germany.

A private funeral will be held at the home on Howard street Wednesday morning, Rev. Trueman J. Menadue of the Little Falls Universalist church, officiating. The remains will be taken to Troy for cremation, and will later be placed in the local cemetery. Friends are asked to omit flowers.
