MRS. ANGELICA C. FULTON, 92, DIES AT WILNA

Carthage, May 8.—Mrs. Angelica Clearwater Fulton, widow of the late Elisha Fulton, died Friday morning at 10 at the home of her son Clark Fulton in Wilna, aged 92 years, six months and 17 days. She had been failing for the past two months but had been confined to bed only a little more than a week.

She was born in Johnstown, Ulster county, the daughter of the late Jacob and Ester¹ Sheley Clearwater. Her father fought in the War of 1812. When she was seven years old, her parents moved to this vicinity and resided for a time in Carthage.

In 1852 she was united in marriage to Elisha Fulton, who died in 1886. After their marriage they went to live on the farm where she died. She had always resided their since her marriage.

She is survived by two sons, Clark and Joseph of Wilna, and one daughter, Mrs. Eugene Lewis of Carthage.

The funeral will be held Monday afternoon at 2 (old time) from her late home, Rev. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist] officiating. Interment will be made in the Fulton cemetery.

She was the last of the Clearwater family.
