FUNERAL OF MRS. FULTON  
Services for an Old Resident of Wilna on Last Saturday

Natural Bridge, Aug. 28—The funeral services of Mrs. Caroline Fulton were held from the Universalist church of which church she had been a life long member, last Saturday at 2 p.m., Rev. G. D. Walker, of Hudson, N.Y., officiating. She had been an old resident of the town of Wilna, and was the widow of James Fulton, who died several years ago. She was 86 years of age. Her health had been failing for several years, terminating with a paralytic shock [stroke] and rendering her unconscious. She lived about one week from the attack.

Mrs. Fulton had a large circle of acquaintances who will be saddened to hear of her death. She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Mary Wilkinson, of Carthage. Mr. and Mrs. Ed. Fulton, of Lowville, and Miss Lucy Fulton, of Carthage, attended the funeral.

Mrs. Fulton was a strong personality and until her recent illness had been very active.

In 1848 she married James, a descendant of Robert Fulton, the great inventor, and up to the time of her death has lived in the home to which she went as a bride 63 years ago. Five children were born to them: John, Francis, Simeon, Lorissa, and Mrs. Mary Wilkinson, of Carthage, who is the only surviving child. She is also survived by one brother, J. W. Nichols, of Natural Bridge, and one sister, Mrs. Levi Snyder, of Nebraska. John Fulton was for many years one of the leading attorneys of Carthage.
